Professional prospects

The public health service is a large and complex institution where the need for collaboration, coordination and communication has received increased attention. Therefore is telemedicine a priority area in several countries. Graduates who understand both the public health service and the technology can be exploited strategically to create new ways of working together. The advantage of having knowledge about the public health service also applies to graduates who will be responsible for the design and development of telemedicine and e-health systems. The master's programme will qualify it's graduates to:

- 3) Apply telemedicine and e-health services in professional health work.
- 4) The master's programme qualifies for researcher education.
