The course provides a thorough introduction to the biological foundation of behaviour and cognition. It focuses on the neural mechanisms for behaviour and cognition, with particular emphasis on sleep, motivation, learning and memory, language, attention, perception and emotions. Lectures are given on important neurological and psychiatric syndromes and disorders with emphasis on the mechanisms behind the different conditions.

The course includes a project equivalent to 2.5 ECTS credits. The project involves writing an essay, usually under supervision and based on a literature search of a topic of choice. The project is evaluated as passed/failed. The student must pass the project assignment before (s)he can take the exam.
